

PANEL DESCRIPTION



- 1. MASTER VOLUME: This knob controls the master volume of the PARTYMAKER BRITE.
- 2. SYNCING to BLUETOOTH DEVICES: Turn power on PARTYMAKER BRITE and (Search for "PARTYLTB" OR "PARTYLTW" on your device, depends on your colour model).

 Short press 1 second to turn off Bluetooth and reconnect to the stored paired device.
- 3. MICROPHONE VOLUME: This knob controls the level of the aux-in input.
- 4. MICROPHONE IN: This supports a 6.35mm(1/4 inch) jack input for microphones and instruments.
- 5. **USB Port :** Used to charge smart devices only (e.g. smart phone, iPod/iPhone/iPad). (Caution: Do not connect external portable hard drives to the USB port as this can result in damage to the unit).
- **6. AUX IN :** 3.5mm (Stereo) jack can be used to connect a CD player, MP3 player, smartphones or other audio sources.
- 7. PARTY DOME LIGHT ON/OFF: Switch to OFF /ON/BEAT (Sound activated lighting effects).
- 8. LIGHTED GRILLE LIGHT ON/OFF: Switch to OFF /ON (To activate programmed pattern lighting effects).
- 9. LIGHTED GRILLE LED MODE: Press to change between programmed pattern lighting effect modes.
- **10. POWER TRANSFORMER :** Insert the included power cord to power the unit. The PARTYMAKER BRITE powers via transformer and does not have internal battery power.
- 11. POWER ON/OFF: Turn the PARTYMAKER BRITE ON or OFF.



IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When used in the directed manner, this unit has been designed and manufactured to ensure your personal safety. However, improper use can result in potential electrical shock or fire hazards. Please read all safety and operating instructions carefully before installation and use, and keep these instructions handy for future reference. Take special note of all warnings listed in these instructions and on the unit.

- 1. Water and Moisture The unit should not be used near water. For example: near a bathtub, washbowl, kitchen sink, laundry tub, swimming pool or in a wet basement.
- 2. Ventilation The unit should be situated so that its location or position does not interfere with its proper ventilation. For example, it should not be situated on a bed, sofa, rug or similar surface that may block ventilation openings. Also, it should not be placed in a built-in installation, such as a bookcase or cabinet, which may impede the flow of air through the ventilation openings.
- **3. Heat** The unit should be situated away from heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves or other appliances (including amplifiers) that produce heat. It should also be kept out of direct sunlight on hot days.
- **4. Power Sources** The unit should be connected to a power supply of the type described in the operating instructions or as marked on the appliance.
- 5. Power Cable Protection Power supply cables should be routed so that they are not likely to be walked on or pinched by items placed upon or against them. It is always best to have a clear area from where the cable exits the unit to where it is plugged into an AC socket.
- 6. Cleaning The unit should be cleaned only using a warm damp cloth. Do not use solvents, etc.
- 7. Objects and Liquid Entry Care should be taken so that objects do not fall and liquids are not spilled into any openings or vents located on the product.
- 8. Attachments Do not use attachments not recommended by the product manufacturer.
- 9. Lightning and Power Surge Protection Unplug the unit from the wall socket and disconnect cable system during a lightning storm or when it is left unattended and unused for long periods of time. This will prevent damage to the product due to lightning and power-line surges.
- **10. Overloading** Do not overload wall sockets, extension cords, or integral convenience receptacles as this can result in a risk of fire or electric shock.
- **11. Damage Requiring Service** The unit should be serviced by qualified service personnel only. For service contact our technical service department
- **12. Periods of Non-use** If the unit is to be left unused for an extended period of time, the power cable should be unplugged from the unit to prevent damage.
- **13. Servicing** The user should not attempt to service the unit beyond those methods described in the user's operating instructions. Service methods not covered in the operating instructions should be referred to qualified service personnel.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- (Q) Why does my PARTYMAKER BRITE light make a grinding noise?
- (A) When you first turn your light on it needs to find it's home position so it can start the sequence that allows the light to emulate the music beats when it detects sound. This is normal, and is the way the device behaves.
- (Q) Why does my PARTYMAKER BRITE fail to pair with my phone?

- (A) If your phone fails to pair, we suggest your restart you phone, try to pair with the unit again making sure your phone is in discover mode. While your phone is scanning you can press the pairing button on the PARTYMAKER BRITE will show up on your phone as PARTYLTB or PARTYLTBW (depending on model colour), and all you need to do is click on this line and you will be connected. If you phone fails to connect it is a problem with your process or your phone. If it fails then redo the above steps, as it never turns out to be the PARTYMAKER BRITE unit.
- (Q) Can I Play music through the USB port?
- (A) With your PARTYMAKER BRITE you cannot play music through the USB as the unit is only a charging port. The USB port is designed to keep your phone charged while you play music from the phone blue-tooth or use you headphone output socket to the AUX input port on your PARTYMAKER BRITE unit.
- (Q) USB not charging
- (A) Check and see if the cable is faulty
- (Q) Why is the Aux input volume lower than the Microphone input volume?
- (A) This is normal as the Mic input has a small amplification circuit to compensate for low level input. You can increase volume from your phone.
- (Q) I have no power and my unit will not turn on.
- (A) First check that you have the power point secured in the wall and it is turned on. Next check that the green light is on and glowing in the window of the power supply unit that was supplied with your PARTYMAKER BRITE. If the light is not there and you have checked the above then contact your supplier.
